NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

## **BLACK WARRIOR RIVER, ALABAMA**

Notice is given to mariners that the Railroad Bridge in Demopolis, known as the Yo-Yo Bridge located at River Mile 219 on the Black Warrior River will be closed undergoing repairs. This operation will begin on October 3, 2008 and continue through October 18, 2008. The bridge will be shut down from 7:00 AM to 12:00 PM Central Daylight Saving Time each day for the next two weeks. The bridge will remain open for navigation from 12:00 noon until 7:00 AM. During the daylight hours after 12:00 noon barges and construction equipment will occupy the navigation channel, essentially blocking it to navigation, but the equipment will be removed from the channel to pass vessels with one hour advance notice by contacting Scott Bridge Company at the bridge on VHF-FM Channel 13 or contacting them by cellular phone at (334) 524-9299. All equipment and barges will be removed from the channel and moored just outside the bridge piers at night with the left span in the up position and lighted according to Navigation Regulations.
