NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

BLACK WARRIOR AND TOMBIGBEE RIVER SYSTEM, ALABAMA

Notice is given to mariners that on or around February 16, 2009 the Scott Bridge Company will begin dredging of 130,000 CY of material for the installation of slope protection (riprap), and the installation of Mooring Dolphins. This work will precede the construction of the ThyssenKrupp Steel Mill River Terminal at Mount Vernon, Alabama, River Mile 41. This work will also consist of the installation of piles, pouring a concrete platform placing backfill behind a retaining wall, and the final placement of a concrete deck for gantry cranes to receive deliveries from barges off the Tombigbee River. There should be no significant delays of the navigable channel, with all efforts being made to minimize obstructions to channel during all phases of construction.

Navigation Bulletins will be updated as construction phases change.

Scott Bridge Company, Inc. vessels will monitor Marine Channels 13 and 16, during working hours or when channel is obstructed.
