NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

APALACHICOLA BAY
GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY, FLORIDA

Notice is given mariners that Inland Dredging Company's dredge "KELLY L" is expected to begin dredging operations in the Apalachicola Bay reach of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway on or about March 9, 2009. Dredging will begin near Mile 354 and work will continue for approximately 60 days. The dredged material will be disposed into approved designated open water sites adjacent to the channel. The dredge will utilize floating and submerged pipeline, in addition to a number of support vessels, all lighted in accordance to U.S. Coast Guard Safety Regulations. The dredge plant can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
