NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

## **BLACK WARRIOR TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, ALABAMA**

Notice is given to mariners that water levels on the Lower Black Warrior/Tombigbee Waterway continue to fall with the current Coffeeville Tailwater being in the 2.5 to 3.0 ft. MSL range on Tuesday morning. Mariners are cautioned that a 2.0 ft. MSL tailwater at Coffeeville is currently needed to obtain a 9.0 ft. channel due to shoaling at Buena Vista Bar Mile 108. We plan to maintain the 9.0 foot navigation channel below Coffeeville; but mariners are further cautioned not to exceed a 9.0 draft when loading barges.

Mariners are urged to exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
