NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

**WOLF AND JOURDAN RIVERS**  
**HARRISON AND HANCOCK COUNTIES, MISSISSIPPI**

Notice is given mariners that AMC's pipeline dredge "POTOMAC III" is expected to begin maintenance dredging on or about September 17, 2009 on the Wolf and Jourdan Rivers near Bay St. Louis Bay, Mississippi. The dredge will start on Wolf River Project and after completion, move to the Jourdan River. All dredging operations are expected to be completed in approximately 90 days. The dredge will be disposing all dredged material into existing Jourdan River Open Water Site. The dredge will utilize floating and submerged pipeline, in addition to support vessels, all lighted in accordance to U.S. Coast Guard Safety Regulations. The dredge plant can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
