NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

PASCAGOULA BEACH RESTORATION
JACKSON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI

Notice is given to mariners that ENCO's pipeline dredge "RUTH H" is expected to begin dredging on the Upper Pascagoula River Channel on or about October 15, 2009. The dredged material will be pumped, by way of pipeline, through the Pascagoula River Channel and used to construct a beach restoration project, located south of Beach Boulevard. This operation is expected to continue for approximately 6 months. The dredge will utilize floating and submerged pipeline, in addition to support vessels, all lighted in accordance to U.S. Coast Guard Safety Regulations. ENCO will begin to lay the floating and submerged pipeline associated with this project on or about September 23, 2009. The dredge plant can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting these areas.
