NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, MISSISSIPPI

Notice is given to mariners that Weyerhaeuser Columbus Cellulose Fibers will be removing 4 of 5 pilings from the Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway. The pilings being removed are between Mile 327.8 and 327.0. Two of the pilings are located on the east bank and the two most northern pilings are located on the west bank. The work will be conducted during daylight hours only and is expected to begin on Wednesday, December 9, 2009 and continue for approximately 7 days. Phillips Contracting will utilize the tugboat "MR. BILL" to remove the pilings, and may be reached on VHF-FM Channels 14 and 16.

Mariners are urged to exercise caution when transiting this area.
