NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

**APALACHICOLA BAY**  
**GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY, FLORIDA**

Notice is given mariners that Inland Dredging Company's dredge "KELLY L" is expected to begin dredging operations in the Apalachicola Bay reach of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway on or about February 6, 2010. Dredging will be performed in the reach from approximately Mile 353 to Mile 360. This work is expected to continue for approximately 30 days. The dredged material will be disposed into approved designated open water sites adjacent to the channel. The dredge will utilize floating and submerged pipeline, in addition to a number of support vessels, all lighted in accordance to U.S. Coast Guard Safety Regulations. The dredge plant can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
