NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

BAYOU CADDY, MISSISSIPPI

Notice is given to mariners that the RCG - Quality Enterprises USA, Inc. JV subcontractor's pipeline dredge 'EDWARD G.' is performing dredging operations under the Mississippi Coastal Improvement Program (MSCIP) at Bayou Caddy (Cadet Bayou) near Lakeshore, Mississippi. The dredging project consists of constructing an approximately 22-acre marsh creation site southward of the mouth of the Bayou Caddy Navigation Project. The dredge will be removing sandy material from an approved borrow area adjacent to the project to construct the containment dikes.

The dredge is expected to be operating at this location for approximately three (3) months, utilizing a combination of floating, submerged, and shore pipe. The dredge will be working during daylight hours only, 7 days per week, and may be reached on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners are urged to exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
