NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

APALACHICOLA BAY
GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY, FLORIDA

Notice is given mariners that Manson Construction Company's dredge "LEONARD J" is expected to begin dredging operations in the Apalachicola Bay reach of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway on or about February 10, 2011. Dredging will be performed on the North-South leg of the channel between Navigation Miles 355.6 and 353.0 for approximately 60 days. The dredged material will be disposed into approved designated open water sites adjacent to the channel. The dredge will utilize floating and submerged pipeline, in addition to a number of support vessels, all lighted in accordance to U.S. Coast Guard Safety Regulations. The dredge plant can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
