NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

PANAMA CITY HARBOR ENTRANCE CHANNEL, FLORIDA

Notice is given to mariners that the Manson Construction Company Dredge "LEONARD J", working under Federal contract, will mobilize to the entrance channel at Panama City Harbor. It is anticipated that maintenance dredging of the channel will begin at the outer bar on April 4, 2011 and proceed northward in the channel. The dredge will operate 24 hours a day 7 days a week, placing the dredge material west of the channel on the St. Andrews State Park Beaches. Dredging is expected to continue for approximately 60 days. The dredge will utilize both floating and submerged pipelines, along with support vessels all lighted in accordance to U.S. Coast Guard Safety Regulations. The dredge can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners are urged to exercise extreme caution when transiting this location.
