**NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:**

**PASCAGOULA HARBOR, MISSISSIPPI**

Notice is given to mariners that Weeks Marine, Inc. pipeline dredge "G.D. MORGAN" is expected to begin maintenance dredging in Pascagoula Harbor around April 20, 2011. Dredging operations are expected to continue for approximately two (2) months in the Upper Sound and Pascagoula River Channels. The dredge material will be disposed into existing open water sites adjacent to the Upper Sound Channel. The dredge will utilize floating and submerged pipeline, in addition to a number of support vessels, all lighted in accordance with U.S. Coast Guard Safety Regulations. The dredge plant can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
