## MOBILE BAY, ALABAMA

Notice is given to mariners that Manson's hopper dredge "BAYPORT" began maintenance dredging in the Mobile Bay Channel. The "BAYPORT" started May 24<sup>th</sup> and dredging will continue for approximately 2 weeks. The dredge will be disposing material into ocean disposal areas 8 and 9. Inland Dredging's cutterhead dredge "INGENUITY" began maintenance dredging in the Mobile River Channel on May 24<sup>th</sup> and will continue for 2 months. Material will be disposed into North Pinto disposal area. Dutra's hopper dredge "COLUMBIA" is dredging the Mobile Bay Channels and placing material into ocean disposal areas. The dredges can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners are urged to exercise extreme caution when transiting these areas.
