NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

BLACK WARRIOR RIVER, ALABAMA

Notice is given to mariners that the Inland Dredge “KELLY L” will begin work at River Mile 116 near Coffeeville Lock on Thursday, July 7, 2011. The dredge will also remove material from the lock lower approach during this assignment. When the dredge moves into the lower approach, navigation traffic will be curtailed for brief periods. The dredge will work 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, and will monitor VHF channel 16. Mariners should not pass without a proper exchange of signals. The dredge will move to River Mile 107 following completion of the dredging at the above location.

Mariners are urged to exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
