NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, MISSISSIPPI

Notice is given to mariners that Manson Construction Company's pipeline dredge "LEONARD J" continues dredging on the Tennessee Tombigbee Waterway. The "LEONARD J" is expected to finish their last Gainesville Lake assignment at Mile 295.8 on or about September 1, 2011. Following the Mile 295.8 assignment, the "LEONARD J" will mobilize down to Demopolis Lake where they will dredge several assignments between Mile 266.0 and 260.0. Dredging operations are expected to continue at these locations until October 15, 2011. The dredge will be working 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, and may be reached on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners are urged to exercise caution when transiting these areas.
