**NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:**

**PANAMA CITY BEACH, FLORIDA**

The Great Lakes Dredge and Dock Company will dredge approximately 1,300,000 cubic yards of sand from a Gulf of Mexico borrow area with placement on Panama City Beach, Florida, for beach nourishment purposes. The material will be pumped by the dredge LIBERTY ISLAND through 5 submerged and floating pipelines, routed 1,500 feet to 3,000 feet off the beach to the designated nourishment areas. Dredging will continue until approximately December 15<sup>th</sup> and will be performed 24-hours a day, 7-days a week. The tug CHESTER CHERAMIE will be monitoring VHF FM Channels 13 or 16.

Mariners are urged to transit the area at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with extreme caution after passing arrangements have been made.
