NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, MISSISSIPPI

Reference is made to Navigation Bulletin 11-47 dated September 28, 2011 which stated the same type of work and location but on a different date.

Notice is given to mariners that Mainstream Commercial Divers will perform maintenance work on an effluent diffuser structure, owned by Weyerhaeuser Columbus Cellulose Fibers. The diffuser structure is located near Mile 327.0 on the Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway. The maintenance work is expected to begin on or about October 31, 2011 and continue approximately 5 days. To ensure the safety of the divers, mariners are strongly encouraged to contact Mainstream Commercial Divers on VHF-FM Channels 14 or 16 before transiting this area. be disposed into existing open water sites adjacent to the channel and an approved beneficial use

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting these areas.
