NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

PENSACOLA HARBOR ENTRANCE CHANNEL, FLORIDA

The Weeks Marine hydraulic cutterhead dredge CAPTAIN FRANK is expected to start dredging the entrance channel on November 26, 2011 and continue dredging for approximately 30 days. The material will be pumped by the dredge submerged and floating pipelines to the designated nourishment areas. Dredging will be performed 24-hours a day, 7-days a week. The dredge will be monitoring VHF FM Channels 13, 16 and 68.

Mariners are urged to transit the area at their slowest safe speed to minimize wake and proceed with extreme caution after passing arrangements have been made.
