NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY
APALCHICOLA BAY, FLORIDA

Notice is given to mariners that Inland Dredging Company's dredge "KELLY L" is expected to begin maintenance dredging operations on or about March 10, 2012 in the Apalachicola Bay reach of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway in Florida. Dredging will be performed in the East-West and North-South section of the Bay, beginning around Mile 358.5 moving westward. This operation is expected to be completed in approximately 30 days. The dredge material will be disposed into existing open water sites adjacent to the channel. The dredge will utilize floating and submerged pipeline, in addition to a number of support vessels. All vessels will be lighted in accordance to U.S. Coast Guard Safety Regulations. The dredge plant can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting these areas.
