NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

BLACK WARRIOR & TOMBIGBEE RIVERS, ALABAMA

Reference is made Navigation Bulletin No. 12-08 dated May 3, 2012, stating that the Coffeeville Lock, River Mile 116, was restricted, with an available channel width of approximately 136 feet.

Notice is given to mariners that the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers motor vessel Lawson has performed emergency maintenance dredging on the shoal at Coffeeville Lower Approach and has successfully re-opened the channel to a width exceeding 200 feet. The channel is marked by two red buoys and two green buoys.

Mariners are urged to exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
