**NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:**

**BLACK WARRIOR & TOMBIGBEE RIVERS, ALABAMA**

Notice is hereby given that the Orion Dredge "RICHARD LAQUAY" began work at River Mile 116.5 near Coffeerville Lock on Monday, June 4, 2012. The dredge will also remove material from the lock lower approach during this assignment. When the dredge moves into the lower approach, navigation traffic will be curtailed for brief periods. The dredge will work 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, and will monitor VHF channel 16. Mariners should not pass without a proper exchange of signals.

Following this assignment, the dredge will move to River Mile 113.8, and then River Mile 108.0.

Mariners are urged to exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
