NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

PASCAGOULA HARBOR DREDGE MATERIAL DISPOSAL SITE,
PASCAGOULA, MISSISSIPPI

Notice is given to mariners that Bertucci Contracting Company, LLC and subcontractor Bean Dredging began constructing the Pascagoula Harbor Dredge Material Disposal Site adjacent to Singing River Island on December 7, 2012. The project will consist of excavating access channels and constructing a riprap containment structure. As part of the riprap containment structure, sand will be excavated and barged from the Upper Pascagoula River Channel to the project site near Singing River Island. Bucket dredges "BEAN 2" and "AB6" will be dredging material from the Upper Pascagoula River Channel. Barge mounted excavators, bucket dredges and other floating plant associated with the project will be working in the vicinity of Singing River Island. Construction is expected to finish around mid August 2013. The dredges can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting these areas.
