NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:

PANAMA CITY ENTRANCE CHANNEL, FLORIDA

Notice is given to mariners that Weeks Marine's cutter-head pipeline dredge "CAPTAIN FRANK" is expected to begin maintenance dredging operations in the Panama City Entrance Channel on or around January 4, 2013. The dredge will be disposing of dredge material onto the beach at St. Andrews State Park in front of Gator Lake and onto the gulf beach west of the jetties. Dredging will continue for approximately 3 weeks. The dredge can be contacted on VHF Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting these areas.
