**NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:**

**GULF INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY**  
**APALACHICOLA BAY, FLORIDA**

Notice is given to mariners that Inland Dredging Company's dredge "KELLY L" is expected to begin maintenance dredging operations on or about 9 January 2013 in the Apalachicola Bay reach of the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway in Florida. Dredging will be performed in the North-South and East-West sections of the Bay, beginning around Mile 351.8 moving eastward. This operation is expected to be completed in approximately 60 days. The dredge material will be hydraulically placed into Disposal Area 2.1, also known as Bird Island, and also into approved open water disposal areas adjacent to the GIWW channel.

The dredge will utilize floating and submerged pipeline, in addition to a number of support vessels. All vessels will be lighted in accordance to U.S. Coast Guard Safety Regulations. The dredge plant can be contacted on VHF-FM Channels 13 and 16.

Mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting these areas.
