**NOTICE TO NAVIGATION INTERESTS:**

**TENNESSEE-TOMBIGBEE WATERWAY, ALABAMA**

Notice is given to mariners that Manson Construction Company's clamshell dredge "ACADIA" will be excavating material near Mile 293, Gainesville Lake, on the Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway. The excavation is associated with bulkhead construction at Westervelt Pellets, which is located on the right descending bank, north of the Hwy 17 Bridge. The work is scheduled to begin on January 12, 2013 and continue twenty-four hours per day, seven days per week for approximately 3 weeks.

The dredge and floating plant can be contacted on VHF-FM Channel 16.

The work activities will be outside the navigation channel, but mariners should exercise extreme caution when transiting this area.
